



COUNTRIES/TERRITORIES/REGIONS WITH COVID-19 VARIANTS OF CONCERN (December 3 to 16. 2021)

Arriving travelers who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 in the Republic of Korea, i.e., have a record of having completed a full regimen of an authorized COVID-19 vaccine series in the Republic of Korea at least two weeks prior to the date of their return to Korea, may be subject to passive monitoring upon return to Korea.

And, by the occurrence of new Omicron variant of the virus, countries/territories/regions with COVID-19 variants of concern has been designated for <u>all countires/terriories/regions from December</u> 3 to 16.

So, if the traveler visited a country/territory/region with COVID-19 variants of concern before returning to Korea, they will be required to undergo mandatory quarantine upon arrival regardless of vaccination status.

- Who have been fully vaccinated in Korea
- Who has Quarantine Exemption documents(as a person who Fully vaccinated overseas.)
- Who has Confirmation of COVID-19 Vaccination(as a person who Fully vaccinated overseas.)

Applied during 3 to 16 December 2021 (based on the date of entry)

NOTE: Countries/Territories/Regions with COVID-19 variants of concern can be changed by trends of Omicron variant occurence
